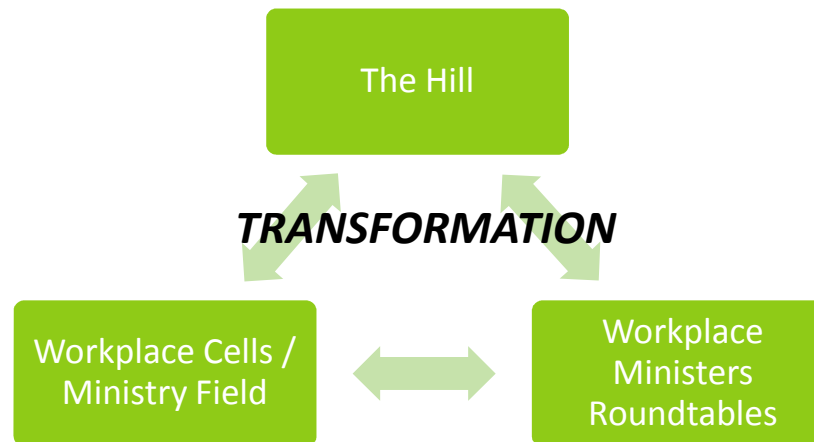
WORKPLACE MINISTRY

⊙ Workplace Ministers Roundtable (WMR)

- ⊙ **Purpose:** Workplace Ministers Roundtable is a group of men and women called to the service of God in the workplace. The purpose of the group is to unite their individual experience, gifting, wisdom, calling, and passion in a roundtable of workplace ministers.
- Workplace: The workplace is the ministry field. The workplace has access to every aspect of our culture. The goal is to transform the workplace through the power and guidance of the Holy Spirit to glorify God.
- Ministers: Ministers are those called to serve God in the workplace. The ministers use their position, relationships, influence and access as their ministry to reclaim our villages, cities, counties, states, regions, nations and world for Jesus Christ.
- Roundtable: The “roundtable” is where workplace solutions and strategies can be derived through the guidance of the Holy Spirit in prayer and study of scripture in the context of the Body of Christ.

WORKPLACE MINISTRY

⊙ Workplace Cell Groups

- ⊙ Workplace Ministers, under the guidance of the Holy Spirit and the support of the church, extends the church into the workplace by developing cell groups.
- ⊙ Cell groups take the form of the Workplace Minister's ministry field.
 - Example: A Workplace Minister, who is a small business owner, belongs to a networking group for leads and referrals. The Lord leads this person to start their own networking group which is Christ centered to minister to other small business owners.
- ⊙ Workplace cell groups extend the reach of the church by meeting people where they are at, introduces them to the saving knowledge of Jesus Christ and naturally connects them into the church, the Body of Christ.
